



ART. 01.- REGISTRATIONS

Registration includes: Maillot or event t-shirt, as appropriate, accident and RC insurance, supplies in the race and at the finish line.

The registration period will end on June 13, 2022 at 10:00 a.m., for the MTB XC Race and on June 18, 2022 at 6:00 p.m., for the Trail and Hiking Race, or once the limit of participants of each test has been reached.

Registrations will not be accepted once the term has expired under any circumstances.

In the Mountain Bike XC Race, all participants who are accredited as FEDERATED, will be deducted -€ 10 from the registration. Although the Federation will check the federated registered, IT IS MANDATORY TO CARRY YOUR LICENSE WHEN COLLECTING THE NUMBER TO MAINTAIN THIS DISCOUNT.

For organizational reasons, online registrations are only accepted through www. paladea. es using the link to the registration form and making the payment through the method established for this purpose.





CANCELLATIONS AND RETURNS

The registration is personal and non-transferable, and the right cannot be transferred to third parties

The registration to Paladea La Oliva contemplates the refund of the amount in the following cases:

- If the cancellation of the test is communicated until 31/05/22 , 50% of the registration value will be returned.
- From 01/06/22 there will be no refund of the registration fee for any case including injuries, accidents, trips, changes of work shift, etc.
- The participant who cannot attend the test, may not transfer their registration to another person under any circumstances, including those of the previous point.
- No modality changes are allowed from 01/06/22 or once the registrations are exhausted.
- In case of partial return, the registered participant will lose the rights related to the broker's bag.
- In case of suspension of the event for health reasons, the total registration will be refunded, except for the amount charged by the bank for the management, which can range between € 1.80 and € 2.50. The organization will not assume in any case, any additional expenses contracted, such as travel, lodging or maintenance expenses.

The fact of registering for the event expressly implies the acceptance of the policy of cancellations and returns exposed in this point, by means of the express consent during the registration process.

ART. 02.- COLLECTION OF RACE BIBS

The organization will provide the mandatory bib number for all participants and the chip for timing.

It is very important the proper placement of the race bib and the chip for identification.

The collection of bibs will be carried out as follows:

- MTB XC: on Friday, June 17, 2022 from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in the PALADEA tent of Villaverde.





- **TRAIL** Race: on Friday , June 17, 2022 from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and the same day of the test, June 19, 2022 from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. in the PALADEA tent of Villaverde.
- **Hiking Route**: no bib is delivered, but they can go on to remove the shirt of the event on Friday , June 17, 2022 from 5:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. and on the same day of the test, June 19, 2022 from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. in the PALADEA tent of Villaverde.

For the withdrawal of the number will be essential the DNI or similar. In no case will bibs that do not correspond to the interested party be delivered unless express written authorization and a copy of the participant's ID.

The attempt or resale of the registration rights and therefore the participation with the number of another person, will mean the expulsion of the test, both of the seller and the buyer.

ARTICLE 08.- DISQUALIFICATIONS

Participants of Paladea La Oliva may be disqualified for any of the following reasons:

- Throw garbage outside the refreshment areas.
- Participate without a helmet in the MTB XC race
- Not obeying the instructions of the referees or staff of the organization.
- Loss of the bib.
- Participate with e-Bike or Gravel bike, you can only participate with MountainBike.
- Arrive out of time at the cut-off points of the race, if any.
- Show unethical conduct with the other participants, with the public or with the members of the organization.





- Put the rest of the participants at risk during the race.
- Receive technical assistance from personnel outside the event.
- Skip checkpoints.

The roads through which the test takes place are open to any vehicle, so the participant aware of this will take extreme precautions in order to avoid dangerous situations, for himself and for third parties. All participants must comply with the provisions of the Road Safety Law. Anyone who does not comply with this will be expelled from the race and may even be sanctioned by the competent authority.

Each participant must ELECTRONICALLY ACCEPT some bases established by the Organization for participation in the test, so that runners who do not accept this document electronically will not be allowed to register. By means of the document, the runner declares that he assumes the risks inherent in the participation in the test open to traffic, and that he excludes the organization of the test from responsibilities for any incident or accident derived from the participation of the test.

The organization is not responsible for any type of accident of which the participant could be a victim or cause, nor for the debts that they may contract during the tests. We inform you that "Paladea La Oliva" will have a Civil Liability insurance and an Accident insurance, for each runner who participates in the event, as established by law.

The participants of Paladea La Oliva, by the fact of registering, give their consent for the organizing club, by itself or through third parties, to treat automatically and for exclusively sporting, promotional or commercial purposes, their personal data.
